## Chair Report

Grants are usually awarded in the late summer/fall.

### **Treasurer Report**

We have mostly just outstanding lunch/milk invoices to pay. There will be a few additional expenses from resource library purchases, greening activities and Gr. 8 Grad. As Council wishes to spend its funding on the students and families who participated in fundraising this school year, we discussed possible "top-up" funding should our account have significantly more than the agreed \$2500 reserve with which to start the school year.

Consensus was to purchase gifts for the office staff who helped support so many Council events throughout the year. Shereene to investigate possible options.

### **Principal Report**

Rick had copies of the Council meeting schedule as well as the draft calendar of events for the school year (including Council fundraisers). Things can be revised but much effort was put into spacing out events so we don't have some of the "crunches" between School and Council events. #### **September Elections**
